Do you remember your first audition?

Were you shy, scared or apprehensive?

Knowing what to expect can be helpful. The audition is very important and starts when you walk in the door. It is important to make a good impression, not only with your talent, but because you pay attention, follow directions, you are courteous and do not cause a distraction.

AUDITION GUIDELINES

THE AUDITION FORM

* Fill out the audition form legibly, completely and accurately.

* Make sure you give the correct contact information (telephone numbers and address)

* List all conflicts.



THE AUDITION

*Arrive on time. Dress comfortably. Relax.

*Be Courteous. Don't create distractions when others are auditioning.

*Show enthusiasm, interest and a positive attitude.

*Project your voice so the Director can hear you.

*Enunciate, do not slur your words.

*Be animated in your interpretation of the lines.

*Pay attention and follow directions.

*If the production is a musical, inquire ahead of time whether you need to bring sheet music, tape or CD accompaniment.

*Decide ahead of time whether you will accept any role other than the one for which you auditioned. Do not accept any role - large or small - unless you are prepared to give it your full effort.

IF YOU DON'T GET THE PART

Unfortunately all will not be cast.

Decisions are made because the Director is looking for people who will fulfill the needs of the production. If you have given a good audition, the Director will remember you the next time you audition.
